Dianne: We will investigate the use of multiple languages in picturebooks and explore how their how their presentation changes according to their status and the purpose of the picturebook.

Nicola: We will meet an author who will share his work in creating a bilingual picturebook. We will look at how picturebooks help us to learn more about ourselves and others and how we can look at wider societal issues though picturebooks: such as gender and poverty.
